**19** And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: For true and righteous are his judgments: for the hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and whath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. 3 And again they said, Alleluia. And ther smoke rose up for ever and ever. 4 And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, "Amen; Alleluia. And a voice came out of the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all "ye his servants, and "ye that fear him, both small and great. And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God <sup>2</sup>omnipotent reigneth. <sup>7</sup>Let us be glad and rejoice, and <sup>2</sup>give honour to him: for <sup>2</sup>the marriage of the Lamb is come, and this wife hath made herself ready. 8 And 4 to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. 9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, "These are the true sayings of God. 10 And 11 fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: "worship God: for "the testimony of Jesus is "the spirit of prophecy.

<sup>11</sup> And I saw <sup>4</sup>heaven opened, and behold <sup>4</sup>a white horse; and <sup>4</sup>he that sat upon him *was* called <sup>16</sup> Faithful and <sup>47</sup>True, and <sup>4</sup>in righteousness he doth judge and make war. <sup>12</sup> <sup>4</sup>His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and <sup>40</sup>on his head *were* many <sup>4</sup>crowns; and he had <sup>4</sup>a name written, <sup>4</sup>that no man knew, but he himself. <sup>13</sup> And he *was* clothed with <sup>4</sup>a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called <sup>16</sup>The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him <sup>4</sup>upon white horses, clothed in <sup>4</sup>fine linen, <sup>4</sup>white and clean. <sup>15</sup>And <sup>4</sup>out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and <sup>4</sup>he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and <sup>44</sup>he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and <sup>16</sup>wrath of <sup>16</sup>Almighty God. <sup>16</sup>And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh <sup>16</sup>a name written, <sup>1</sup>KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

<sup>17</sup> And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to "all the fowls "that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather yourselves together "unto the supper of "the great God; <sup>18</sup> That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of "captains, and "the flesh of mighty men, and "the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men, both* "free and bond, both 'small and great. <sup>19</sup> And I saw "the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, "gathered together "to make war against "him that sat on the horse, and against his army. <sup>20</sup> And "the beast was taken, and with him "the false prophet "that wrought "miracles "before him, with which he "deceived "them that had received the mark of the beast, and "them that worshipped his image. These both "were cast alive into a lake "of fire burning with brimstone. <sup>21</sup> And the remnant were slain with the sword of "him that sat upon the horse, "which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and 'all the fowls were filled with their flesh.
