

**19** And after these things <sup>a</sup>I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, <sup>b</sup>Alleluia; <sup>c</sup>Salvation, and <sup>d</sup>glory, and <sup>e</sup>honour, and <sup>f</sup>power, unto the Lord our God: <sup>2</sup>For <sup>g</sup>true and righteous *are* his judgments: for <sup>h</sup>he hath judged <sup>i</sup>the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and <sup>j</sup>hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. <sup>3</sup>And again they said, <sup>b</sup>Alleluia. And <sup>k</sup>her smoke rose up for ever and ever. <sup>4</sup>And <sup>l</sup>the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, <sup>m</sup>Amen; <sup>b</sup>Alleluia. <sup>5</sup>And a voice came out of the throne, saying, <sup>n</sup>Praise our God, all <sup>o</sup>ye his servants, and <sup>p</sup>ye that fear him, <sup>q</sup>both small and great. <sup>6</sup>And I heard as it were <sup>r</sup>the voice of a great multitude, and <sup>s</sup>as the voice of many waters, and <sup>t</sup>as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, <sup>b</sup>Alleluia: for <sup>u</sup>the Lord God <sup>v</sup>omnipotent reigneth. <sup>7</sup>Let us be glad and rejoice, and <sup>w</sup>give honour to him: for <sup>x</sup>the marriage of the Lamb is come, and <sup>y</sup>his wife hath made herself ready. <sup>8</sup>And <sup>z</sup>to her was granted that she should be <sup>a</sup>arrayed in <sup>b</sup>fine linen, <sup>c</sup>clean and <sup>d</sup>white: for <sup>e</sup>the fine linen is <sup>f</sup>the righteousness of saints. <sup>9</sup>And he saith unto me, <sup>g</sup>Write, <sup>h</sup>Blessed *are* they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, <sup>i</sup>These are the true sayings of God. <sup>10</sup>And <sup>j</sup>I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, <sup>k</sup>See *thou do it* not: I am <sup>l</sup>thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that <sup>m</sup>have the testimony of Jesus: <sup>n</sup>worship God: for <sup>o</sup>the testimony of Jesus is <sup>p</sup>the spirit of prophecy.

<sup>11</sup> And I saw <sup>q</sup>heaven opened, and behold <sup>r</sup>a white horse; and <sup>s</sup>he that sat upon him *was* called <sup>t</sup>Faithful and <sup>u</sup>True, and <sup>v</sup>in righteousness he doth judge and make war. <sup>12</sup> <sup>w</sup>His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and <sup>x</sup>on his head *were* many <sup>y</sup>crowns; and he had <sup>z</sup>a name written, <sup>a</sup>that no man knew, but he himself. <sup>13</sup> And he *was* clothed with <sup>b</sup>a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called <sup>c</sup>The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him <sup>d</sup>upon white horses, clothed in <sup>e</sup>fine linen, <sup>f</sup>white and clean. <sup>15</sup> And <sup>g</sup>out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and <sup>h</sup>he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and <sup>i</sup>he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and <sup>j</sup>wrath of <sup>k</sup>Almighty God. <sup>16</sup> And he hath on <sup>l</sup>his vesture and on his thigh <sup>m</sup>a name written, <sup>n</sup>KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

<sup>17</sup> And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to <sup>o</sup>all the fowls <sup>p</sup>that fly in the midst of heaven, <sup>q</sup>Come and gather yourselves together <sup>r</sup>unto the supper of <sup>s</sup>the great God; <sup>18</sup> <sup>t</sup>That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of <sup>u</sup>captains, and <sup>v</sup>the flesh of mighty men, and <sup>w</sup>the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men, both* <sup>x</sup>free and bond, both <sup>y</sup>small and great. <sup>19</sup> And I saw <sup>z</sup>the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, <sup>a</sup>gathered together <sup>b</sup>to make war against <sup>c</sup>him that sat on the horse, and against his army. <sup>20</sup> And <sup>d</sup>the beast was taken, and with him <sup>e</sup>the false prophet <sup>f</sup>that wrought <sup>g</sup>miracles <sup>h</sup>before him, with which he <sup>i</sup>deceived <sup>j</sup>them that had received the mark of the beast, and <sup>k</sup>them that worshipped his image. These both <sup>l</sup>were cast alive into a lake <sup>m</sup>of fire burning with brimstone. <sup>21</sup> And the remnant were slain with the sword of <sup>n</sup>him that sat upon the horse, <sup>o</sup>which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and <sup>p</sup>all the fowls were filled with their flesh.
