

13 Let ^abrotherly love continue. ^{2b}Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby ^csome have entertained angels unawares. ^{3d}Remember them that are in bonds, ^eas bound with them; *and* them which ^fsuffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body. ^{4g}Marriage *is* honourable in all, and ^hthe bed undefiled: but ⁱwhoremongers and ^kadulterers ^lGod will judge. ⁵*Let your* conversation *be* ^mwithout covetousness; *and* ⁿ*be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, ^oI will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. ⁶So that we may boldly say, ^pThe Lord *is* my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. ⁷Remember them which ^qhave the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: ^rwhose faith follow, considering ^sthe end of *their* ^tconversation. ⁸Jesus Christ ^uthe same ^vyesterday, and to day, and for ever. ⁹Be not ^wcarried about with divers and strange ^xdoctrines. For *it is* a good thing that the heart be established with grace; ^ynot with meats, ^zwhich have not profited them that have been occupied therein. ¹⁰We have ^{aa}an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle. ¹¹For ^{bb}the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into ^{cc}the sanctuary by the high priest ^{dd}for sin, ^{ee}are burned without ^{ff}the camp. ¹²Wherefore Jesus also, that he might ^{gg}sanctify the people with his own blood, ^{hh}suffered ⁱⁱwithout the gate. ¹³Let us ^{jj}go forth therefore unto him without ^{kk}the camp, bearing ^{ll}his reproach. ¹⁴For ^{mm}here have we no continuing city, but we seek ⁿⁿone to come. ¹⁵By him therefore let us offer ^{oo}the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, ^{pp}the fruit of *our* lips ^{qq}giving thanks to his name. ¹⁶But to do good and ^{rr}to communicate ^{ss}forget not: for with ^{tt}such sacrifices ^{uu}God is well pleased. ¹⁷^{aa}Obey them that ^{bb}have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: ^{cc}for they ^{dd}watch for your souls, as they that must ^{ee}give account, ^{ff}that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that *is* unprofitable for you. ¹⁸^{gg}Pray for us: for we trust we have ^{hh}a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. ¹⁹But I beseech *you* ⁱⁱthe rather to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner.

²⁰Now ^{jj}the God of peace, ^{kk}that ^{ll}brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great ^{mm}shepherd of the sheep, through ⁿⁿthe blood of the everlasting ^{oo}covenant, ^{pp}Make you perfect ^{qq}in every good work ^{rr}to do his will, ^{ss}working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; ^{tt}to whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen. ²²And I beseech you, brethren, suffer the word of ^{uu}exhortation: for ^{vv}I have written a letter unto you in few words. ²³Know ye that ^{ww}our brother ^{xx}Timothy is set at liberty; with whom, if he come shortly, I will see you. ²⁴Salute all them that ^{yy}have the rule over you, and ^{zz}all the saints. They of ^{aa}Italy salute you. ²⁵^{bb}Grace *be* with you all. Amen.
